- Students must complete 100 hours of nurse assistant curriculum to be eligible to sit for the Massachusetts Certified Nurse Assistant Exam.
- Students must sign and be able to perform the requirements within the Technical Standards. community.northshore.edu/programs/xcn/ program_technical_standards
- In order to stay current those working in the field must update their CPR/AED certification every two years.

Advising Notes

- This program is intended upon completion to prepare a student for the Massachusetts Certified Nurse Assistant Exam. Upon scoring high enough on this exam, students are eligible for entry level employment as a nurse assistant. Massachusetts Nurse Aide State Testing Information Guide
